



Your VBYC to Open Tuesday June 2!

Pursuant to Governor DeSantis full “Phase One” Executive Order your Vero Beach Yacht Club will be reopening Tuesday June 2, under the following full “Phase One” guidelines:

These Guidelines Will Be Strictly Enforced

Inside Dining ~ RESERVATIONS MANDATORY (for dining or drinks)

- 1. Members Only (NO Guests)**
2. Allowable seating ~ 50% of maximum occupancy or 144 members.
3. Seating at designated tables only, to ensure the 6 feet distancing requirement. Please do NOT add additional chairs
4. No seating or gathering at the bar. Drinks provided at your table
5. Maximum members at a table (10) where permitted.

Outside Dining ~ RESERVATIONS MANDATORY (for dining or drinks)

- 1. Members Only (NO Guests)**
2. Allowable seating ~ 100% of capacity with 6 feet between tables
3. Seating at designated tables only, to ensure the 6 feet distancing requirement
4. No seating or gathering at the bar. Drinks provided at your table
5. Maximum members at a table (6) Do Not add additional chairs

The above is hopefully a temporary measure. We will update these guidelines when the various government agencies authorize any changes.

Hours of Operation:

Lunch: Wednesday, Thursday & Friday ~ 11am – 1pm

Dinner: Tuesday through Saturday ~ 5:30 - 8:30p

Sunday Breakfast Buffet: 10am – 1:00pm (served by staff)

Take Out with Curbside Delivery will be available during all hours of operation.

The Health and Safety of our Members and Staff is our Utmost Priority!

Pre-Opening Mitigation Efforts:

1. All chairs have been steam cleaned
2. All carpets have been steam cleaned
3. All hard surfaces have been sanitized
4. Entire clubhouse has been fogged with Vital Oxide. A sanitizing fogging process used in hospitals
5. The club's air quality is superior to most facilities. It was engineered with a perfect balance of fresh and conditioned air to force droplets to the ground much quicker. Additionally, UV lights were installed throughout our ductwork.

VBYC Staff Return To Work Policy:

No employee will be allowed to report to work or enter the club if any of the following situations have happened within 14 days of the date you are requested to work.

- If you have traveled out of the state by plane, train or any other mass transit. Or have taken a cruise, you should self-quarantine for 14 days
- If you have been in contact or are residing with anyone who has traveled from out of state by plane, train or any other mass transit including by vehicle. You should self-quarantine for 14 days.
- If your spouse, significant other or any family members work in the health care industry who may directly or indirectly work around Covid19 infected patients.
- If you are experiencing any symptoms of a cold, flu, have a sore throat, runny nose, feeling achy or have a fever.

Please note all employees will have their temperature taken with an infrared forehead thermometer before being allowed to work. If you show any signs of a fever you will be asked to go home.

Member Return To Club Recommendations:

- Please refrain from using the club if you or a family member are experiencing any symptoms of a cold, flu, have a sore throat, runny nose, feeling achy or have a fever.
- Please refrain from using the club if you or a family member have traveled out of the state by plane, train or any other mass transit. Or have taken a cruise, you should self-quarantine for 14 days
- If you are comfortable wearing a mask and or gloves please do.
- To reduce constant and prolonged exposure with staff consider pre-ordering your meal when reserving your table.

Mitigation Efforts While You Are At The Club:

- All staff must meet the “Return To Work Policy” before being allowed to work
- All staff are required to wear masks and gloves
- Hand sanitizer stations will be positioned throughout the club
- All allowable tables will have hand sanitizer placed on them (please do not remove)
- A designated staff member on the patio and in the clubhouse will be assigned to continually clean and sanitize all hard surfaces with commercial grade sanitizing solution
- Tables will not be preset with glassware, utensils or condiments. If you are dining, these items will be presented at that time.
- The club has purchased UV light wands to sanitize menus and other porous materials.

All the above efforts are in compliance with the full “Phase One” guidelines. They are intended to provide the safest possible environment while using your club.

Please evaluate your own personal risk before expanding your exposure

Additional VBYC Activities Schedule & Guidelines

- Games ~ All Bridge, Poker, Mahjong, Rummikub and other games **are suspended through June 30, 2020**
- Pickle ball may resume beginning June 2
- Friday Night DJ Dance Party expected to resume in July
- Saturday night music will resume June 6
- Wednesday night music on the patio will resume June 3
- Some previously scheduled special entertainment will begin in June and continue throughout the summer
- The club boat "Friendship" will be available for rental beginning June 2
- Kayak rentals will be available beginning June 2
