



Proclamation



WHEREAS, the Vero Beach Yacht Club was created as a private club in 1926 with the original charter outlining an intention to work with the City and build and maintain dockage in order to bring visitors to Vero Beach; and

WHEREAS, in 1938, the Vero Beach Yacht Club built their first dock and managed it and also were responsible for maintaining the City Marina up until the early 70's; and

WHEREAS, their current building was built in the early 60's and virtually destroyed along with their docks in the 2004 hurricanes but, with the dedication of their members, in a little over four months, the club was up and operational again; and

WHEREAS, the club in the late 60's and early 70's was composed of very young people, mainly young men in their early 20's and has grown over the years with boating enthusiasts to their current total of 530 members comprised of both couples and singles of varying age groups.

NOW, THEREFORE, Jay Kramer, Mayor of the City of Vero Beach, Florida does hereby proclaim January 14, 2016 as Vero Beach Yacht Club Day. The community is invited to join in celebrating their 90th Anniversary.
