SUMMERTIME AND THE GRILLING IS EASY

It's grilling season. So, what kind of wine goes with grilled food? When asked what wine he prefers with bar-b-que a noted Chef respond, "Beer". Although that does bear some credence, there are also some really good pairings of wines with grilled foods.

For beef a big, bold wine with tannins, perhaps a Cabernet Sauvignon or a Meritage blend. Grilled pork pairs well with fruit, such as apples, and likewise pairs well with fruity wines, such as a red Zinfindel. Chardonnay, especially lightly oaked or stainless steel aged, works quite well with grilled



poultry. But don't pass on a Viognier or Gruner Veltliner. For the bigger flavor of turkey, try a dry Reisling or a Pinot Noir.

Seafood provide a great chance to showcase sparkling wines, i.e. Champagne or Prosecco. From Spain and Portugal comes the lightly sparkling wine, Vino Verdhe (green wine) which has the added benefit of low alcohol, making it a perfect summer quaffer. For heavier fish, such as tuna or salmon, Viognier, Gruner Veltliner, or Pinot Noir.

Shellfish requires something dry, acidic, and minerally. French Sancerre and Chablis are great choices. Of course any of the Brut sparkling wines above work wonderfully well.

When thinking of BBQ, spicy marinades and tangy sauces come to mind. To offset the tanginess, consider wines with a bit of sweetness, such as German Riesling or Gewurztraminer. For a lightly tangy sauce, lighter Rose, either French or US work well. For sauce with a bit more of a bite, try a Spanish Rose, since they tend to be bigger, darker, bolder wines.

Regardless of what you decide to throw on the grill, you can find a wine to go with it. If you like it, it's a good pairing. Or, if you prefer, beer is great too.



The Club is setting up a variety of wine events for October through April of the upcoming season. There will be several pairing dinners, as well as more casual events. The current plan is to continue to use the second Thursdays of each month for the events, so mark those dates on your calendar. Your comments or suggestions for future activities are needed.
