FLORIDA COUNCIL OF YACHT CLUBS NEWS



The November FCYC meeting was held at Florida Yacht Club in Jacksonville. Both Judy Peschio (our Alternate Director) and I attended.

This is a lovely club and the oldest in Florida. It is situated on a peninsula

in a very attractive neighborhood bordering the St. Johns River. I encourage a visit if you are in the area. If planning a cruise, be sure to call ahead. Some of their dockage is still compromised from hurricane Irma.

Cruising Guide: The council is initiating a new policy regarding the publication of the Cruising Guide. By Jan. 15, 2020 the guide will be posted online for members to print just the information they need. This will allow more frequent updates and reduce the cost of the published paper guide.

Temporary lock closing: The Banana River lock access to the Canaveral Barge Canal will be closed from Dec. 1, 2019 to Mar. 31, 2020.

Okeechobee Water Levels: Lake "O" water levels are trending low. Captains planning a crossing should be cautious and know the levels before entering the lake.

Policy on Divers (bottom maintenance): A question was raised about the management of divers doing maintenance on member boats. A diver was injured at a marina (not a FCYC club) which raised the issue of awareness when divers are at work. An informal survey indicated about a quarter of the member clubs had a policy in effect. At a minimum, always check the environment before engaging your vessel.

Cruise to Gasparilla Island (Boca Grande area): The FCYC West Coast Fleet Captain is planning a cruise to this beautiful island for May 2020. Details will be forthcoming.

Yachtsmen of the Year: Captains seeking this honor must turn their logs in by January 15, 2020.

Next meeting: Tampa Yacht & Country Club January 10-12, 2020.

March meeting: will be held at Isles YC in Punta Gorda, FL. If you plan to go be sure to make lodging plans early. Hotel rooms during this period are expected to be difficult to find.
